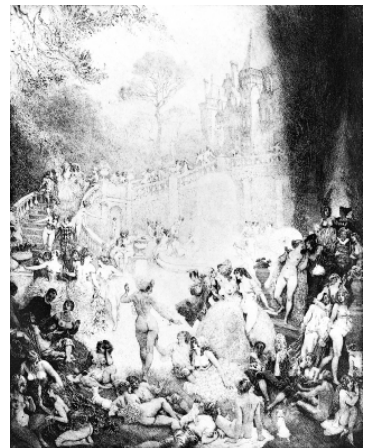
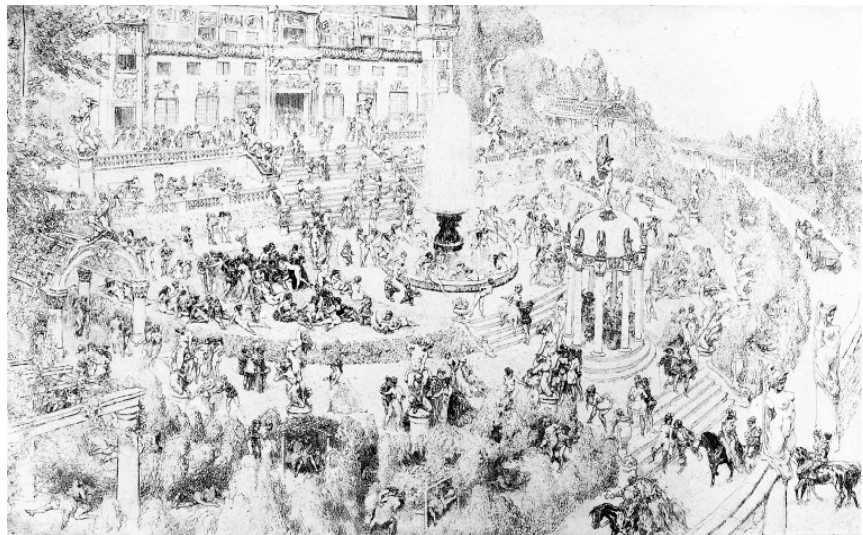

## NO NEW FACSIMILE ETCHINGS FOR CHRISTMAS

Due to the ongoing global financial crisis we are very conscious of the burden this has placed on our friends and clients. Consequently, we have decided not to release another Facsimile Etching at the end of this year. Over the last few years, we have traditionally released one or two images in the first half of the year (between March and June) and another one or two at the end of the year — usually in November in time for Christmas. We know times are tough for us all and with a selection of eighteen works, this gives an excellent choice of current releases. We will now look towards the middle of next year before we release a new Facsimile Etching for sale.

*Visitors to Hell* and *Night's Frolic* have now both sold out and *Atlantis* will be the next to go. These three images are all large in size and so when *Atlantis* is sold out, there will be no large current Facsimile Etchings to choose from. Next year we are considering releasing two large works mid year and our short-list includes *The Apex of Life* (below left), *Castle Fanfrolico* (directly below), *Galleon's End* (below centre) and *Micomicon* (below right).
